VIDEO CONFERENCES


At the discretion of the court, attorneys may attend pretrial conferences or civil hearings in which testimony will not be required by video provided that the attorney complies with the following:


IT IS ORDERED that the attorney wishing to attend by video conference fax a letter to the Judge's office of the particular division in which the civil matter is pending, advising the Law Clerk of that division of the date of the conference and who will be attending by video.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that the presence of anyone without consent of the court, or any recording of the video conference by unauthorized persons may be considered contempt of court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proper attire is required for video conferences.
