ORDER

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Subsection 1, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the current freezing temperatures and unsafe conditions at the courthouses due to lack of water and restroom facilities in the Madison Parish Courthouse and considering this renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Sixth Judicial District Court and Madison Parish Clerk's Office to continue in the performance of their official duties, and for the general public to conduct business at the Parish Courthouses:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Sixth Judicial District Court, Parish of Madison and the Madison Parish Clerk's Office shall be closed today at noon and will reopen on **January 22, 2024 at 9:30 am** unless the closing is further extended by Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
