**ORDER**

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Subsection 1, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the inclement weather and emergency warnings issued by the National Weather Service for East Carroll, Madison and Tensas Parishes and the surrounding areas and considering this renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Sixth Judicial District Court to continue in the performance of their official duties, and for the general public to conduct business at the Parish Courthouse:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Sixth Judicial District Court, Parishes of East Carroll, Madison and Tensas and the Clerk's Offices for those parishes shall be closed on Tuesday, January 16, 2024. The Sixth Judicial District Court and the Sixth Judicial Clerk's Offices will re-open on Wednesday, January 17, 2024 unless the closing is further extended by Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
